- Unofficial high school or college transcript with one year of algebra (C or higher)
- OR-Placement test scores: MTH 70 or higher
- OR—GED with a math score of 150 or higher

Note: Employers may later require a current driver's license, insurability to operate company vehicles, a drug test or other tests, or the ability to lift/move 50-pound material

**HVAC/R Technician:** HVAC/R (heating, ventilating, air conditioning, and refrigeration) combines sheet metal and electrical work for installation, wiring, service, repair of environmental control systems, and fabrication and installation of ductwork.
